



## Charlie's Soap is HE compatible

First there were rocks in the stream on which to smash your clothes. Then there were ribbed washboards, hand-cranked spinning contraptions and then electric top-loading washers. Today, it's high efficiency or HE front- and top-loaders. Some take only liquids, some take only powder and some will take either. They are here to stay. Charlie's Soap works for ALL front- loading, top-loading, large, small, stacked, HE (and everything in between) washing machines. Charlie's Soap is:

Your family will be safe because of our non-toxic formula.

**That CLEANS:** Nothing cleans as thoroughly as Charlie's Soap. (SGS Testing Labs)  
Rinses away completely. (Clemson University School of Textiles)  
Just a tiny dose for a large load. (1 fl. oz. Liquid or 1 TBSP Powder)  
Will continuously clean your machine.

### Here are a few helpful tips if you are a first-time user:

- Clean your machine of all residues of other detergents before doing your wash in Charlie's Soap.
- Put **2 TBSP Powder** or **2 oz. Liquid** into the machine and some old rags and run a full cycle with a double rinse.
- Apply Charlie's Soap directly to clothes, bypassing the dispenser when possible because some dispensers don't put enough water on the detergent – and it never gets down to the clothes.
- Those residues are also in your clothes, so expect it to take a few washes to get them all out.

### How much should you use?

#### **1 oz. Liquid or 1 TBSP Powder on the following machines:**

- Standard front -and top-loaders (large load)
- HE front -and top-loaders (large load)
- On front-loading HE machines, you may notice large amounts of suds until all your garments have been washed a few times. If suds do not diminish with time, reduce dose to 3/4 oz. Liquid 3/4 TBSP Powder. Constant use of Charlie's Soap will keep your machine clean. Leave the door open on front loaders to keep mildew away.

#### **3/4 oz. Liquid or 3/4 TBSP Powder** on the following machines.

- Medium load on standard top- and front-loaders.
- Large load in small capacity top- or front-loading HE machines
- Stackable units
- RV (recreational vehicle) units, which are conventionally small

**2 oz. Liquid or 1.5 TBSP (heaping spoonful) Powder** on super capacity front-loaders (4.0 ft<sup>3</sup> and larger) or laundromat triple-loaders. (If using Charlie's Soap at a laundromat, take care to clean the machine as indicated above).
